Information

Thai Hip and Knee Society (THKS) is highly respected specialty society of hip and knee arthroplasty surgeons in Thailand.

THKS launches the arthroplasty visiting fellowship scholarships to promote education and experience in the fields of hip and knee arthroplasty. This program also provides the training on updates practical hip and knee arthroplasty points including discussion the procedures and all aspects of patient management, and share research experience in hip and knee arthroplasty issues.

The visiting fellowships provide a possibility to introduce the traditions and the culture of host countries. They can make the strong connection between hip and knee orthopedic surgeons in each community.

Eligible applicants

- Age 45 years or less
 - Can communicate effectively in English and have a legal status to go abroad
 - Have a university level degree or country equivalent and have specialist qualifications for hip & knee arthroplasty or its equivalent
 - The application must be submitted on the official application form.
 - The fellow is responsible for obtaining of visa, as well as for their health and travel insurance

Activities

Fellowship program will be held at Bangkok, Thailand, for **nine weeks from 2 October - 1 December, 2023**. Four fellowships will be accepted and were divided into two groups. Each group will spend 2 periods of one month in hip and knee arthroplasty excellence centers in Bangkok metropolitan region.

All fellows **must have** an oral presentation of their recent studies in the 25th annual meeting of Thai Hip & Knee Society at Hua-Hin, Prachuap Khiri Khan on 2 - 4 December 2023.

Grant

Each fellowship grant covers 1) the economy class return airfare 2) apartment/hotel accommodation in Bangkok 3) THKS 2023 meeting registration fee and 4) hotel accommodation in Hua-hin during the meeting.

Documents for submitting your application, please include:

1. Brief curriculum vitae (not more than 4 pages)
 - a. Qualifications (including degree(s), institution (s) and years)
 - b. Present appointment(s)
 - c. Training and experience in Hip & Knee Arthroplasty
2. Scanned copies of certificates and qualifications
3. Recommended letter
4. Scanned copy of passport – with at least 6 months validity
5. Research abstract of not more than 300 words. This abstract will be used for oral presentation in the 25th annual meeting of Thai Hip & Knee Society, as well as during the fellowship.

Closing date

The **closing date** for complete application is **31 August 2023**.
